Pigs: Berkshire, British Lop, British Saddleback, **Kune Kune**, Gloucester Old Spot, Large Black, Middle White, Oxford Sandy, & Black, Tamworth, Welsh.

This show qualifies for the Berkshire Breeders Club Champion of Champions. Novice class for exhibitors with not more than 3 wins prior to show. Pigs must be the sole property of the exhibitor. Classes for pigs shown by children in age groups Under 8, 8-11, 11-16 years. Entries (free) for above two classes should be notified to Steward at show Enter name and age of children on reverse of entry form. Junior pigs will be penned together unless otherwise stated.

Classes will be divided or amalgamated where entries permit. Passes and directions will be sent after the closing date of 24th April.

Animals may be delivered to the showground after 8 a.m. on 3rd May 2020 Gates open to the public 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. Judging starts 11am.
